

Chorus Room

Middle & High School

The chorus room for middle & high school easily accommodates both small- and large-group choral ensembles. Standing risers make it easy to divide the choral group by voice type, while still giving students enough personal space to remain comfortable as they sing. Music chairs can be used for smaller groups or individual vocal lessons, and quickly stored out of the way when they're not needed.

Requirements for a Great Chorus Room

For **students**, the chorus room should provide a spacious set of risers so students can easily arrange themselves by voice type. Risers should be positioned so that all students have a clear view of the music teacher. Storage for sheet music should be easily accessible.

For **teachers**, the chorus room should be equipped with a director's area, positioned in a place with clear sightlines to all students. A wide walkway in front of the risers makes it easy for the teacher to move from the piano to the different voice groups. Storage for sheet music and personal belongings storage should be available to keep the room organized.

For **administrators**, the chorus room should be furnished in a way that meets the needs of their school's music program. Products must be readily available and delivered on time. Installation should be quick and efficient

A dedicated **singer's area**, **director's area** and **storage area** make creating a great chorus room simple.

The singer's area seats small and large choral ensembles, so they have a clear view of the director.

- Tiered **risers** arranged at an angle, allow all chorus members to easily see the conductor. Risers must be wide enough to allow students to easily enter and exit, and to hold sheet music as they sing.
- Music chairs with straight backs ensure proper posture while singing. Contoured seats keep students comfortable during practice.
- Music stands should be height-adjustable, and sturdy enough to support folders as well as sheet music.

The director's area should be positioned so that the music teacher can be easily seen by all students in the room.

- A comfortable **swivel stool** equipped with casters allows the director to quickly move from facing the piano, to facing the singers. An armless design ensures they can play the piano unhindered.
- A music-lined **dry-erase board** features a set of staff lines, making it simple for the conductor to provide musical examples to the class, or to teach aspects of music theory.
- An adjustable-height music stand holds the conductor's music.
- A teacher's desk gives the music educator a plan to plan lessons, select music, make assessments or meet with individual students.

The storage area keeps belongings and sheet music organized and easy to find.

- A lockable storage cabinet secures materials that may require teacher supervision. Teachers may also opt to use this cabinet to secure their personal belongings.
- Slotted **sheet music storage** makes sheet music easy to access. Each slot can be assigned to a student, ensuring they can easily find their music at the start of class.
- **Open shelving** provides a place where students can leave their bookbags and other belongings, keeping them out of the way during choral practice.
